## Faith Formation

- **Sacramental Preparation:** Classes to prepare to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, or Matrimony.
- **RCIA:** Preparation for Adults to be received in the Catholic Church or to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, or first Eucharist.
- **Religious Education:** Classes to educate young people in the Catholic Faith.
- **St. Rose of Lima School:** A Parochial school to educate our young people (K-8).
- **Bible Studies:** Study Scripture and doctrine (Spanish and English)
- **Alianza de Amor:** A Spanish bible study and prayer group.
- **Grupo de Oracion de la renovacion carismatica:** A Spanish charismatic prayer group.
- **Liturgy of the Word for Children:** Help the children receive the Gospel Message at Mass.
- **Various Prayer Groups:** Men and Women gathered to pray for deeper union with God.
- **Gospel of Life:** Promotes the study of issues such as Abortion, Euthanasia, Death Penalty.
- **Men of St. Joseph:** Pray together, read scriptures, and foster authentic masculinity in order to be spiritual leaders of their families.
- **Heart of Mary Women's Ministry:** Meet with your sisters in Christ as we develop our relationship with Jesus and Mary.

## Parish Life

- **Hospitality Ministers:** Persons who serve as “welcomers” to anyone attending the church.
- **Faith and Light:** A group which tends to the needs of developmentally disabled students.
- **Deaf Community:** Provide Sign language to our parish and celebrates Mass with them.

- **Altar & Rosary Society:** Attend to needs to altar linens and sacred vessels.

- **Senior Group:** uniting senior citizens twice a month for liturgy, activities, fellowship.
