**Second Sunday of Ordinary Time**

As we begin this short period of Ordinary Time, a person may have the idea that this season is less important or insignificant in comparison to the great feasts of Christmas, Easter, and the discipline of Lent. Does Jesus have time for ordinary people in their small ordinary lives or problems? During the Wedding Feast at Cana, Jesus performs His first miracle, turning water into wine so that the host would not be embarrassed. (Big deal! You would think that the Son of God could accomplish a greater miracle at first; I personally prefer the walking on water as an opening act. That would have gotten everyone's attention.) Jesus quietly changes ordinary water into divinely sweet wine; and only the ordinary servants witness His great action. Jesus performs miracles quietly in ordinary situations and in ordinary lives. These miracles happen everyday in the ordinary details of our lives. Do you recognize God's sweet transformations in your daily life?

**Segundo Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario**

Al comenzar este periodo breve del tiempo ordinario, alguna persona podría pensar que la idea del tiempo ordinario es menos importante, o insignificante, comparado a las grandes fiestas de Navidad, Pascua y la disciplina de la cuaresma. Hay una perspectiva común que Jesús no tiene tiempo para la gente ordinaria con sus pequeñas vidas y problemas ordinarios. Sin embargo, el tiempo ordinario nos habla directamente a las personas ordinarias. Las bodas de Cana se enfocan en el hecho de que Jesús hace su primer milagro en una fiesta, convirtiendo el agua en vino para que no se avergonzara el anfitrión. ¡Grandioso! Uno pensaría que el hijo de Dios podría haber logrado un milagro más grande primero; yo en lo personal hubiera preferido el caminar sobre agua como el primer acto -- eso hubiera llamado la atención de todos. En vez de eso, Jesús cambia el agua ordinaria a un vino divinamente dulce, y solo los sirvientes ordinarios son testigos de su gran acción. Jesús hace milagros silenciosamente en situaciones ordinarias y en vidas ordinarias. Estos milagros ocurren diariamente en los detalles ordinarios de nuestras vidas. ¿Reconoces tú las dulces transformaciones que Dios hace en tu vida diaria?

Parking

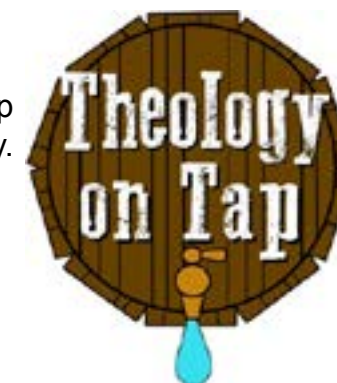
As of the end of this year we will no longer have access to park in the parking spaces/dirt lot behind KFC. Please park at the Gateway parking structure located across the street.
