Fifth Sunday of Ordinary Time

“Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch.” These are the words given to Simon-Peter and companions after a long night of fishing with no results. However, with trust in Jesus, they go and do as they are told and a miraculous abundance of fish is given to these fishermen.

Simon reacts in a very common way: he falls to his knees in tears, saying, “Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man.” How many times do we act like Simon? We deem ourselves unfit for the grace of God by rejecting His mercy, or we ignore the presence and miracles of Christ in our lives. We simply claim that it was “good luck” or pass it off as mundane.

Obviously, this is not good, for example: do you recognize the miraculous presence of Christ when you take from His table and eat? Every time? Every Sunday we get more than a net full of fish.

Simon-Peter is an example for us. Simon listens to Jesus and follows Him with TRUST. Simon becomes a man of action, leaving behind his old job of catching fish to do the will of Christ and “fish” for men.

Taking Simon-Peter’s example, we are to trust in Christ and push ourselves out into the deep waters, which are risky and full of uncertainty. Drop nets in search of what Christ intends for us. A person does this by receiving the sacraments, studying scripture, participating in the community, giving daily time to prayer, and in many other ways.

This is certainly risky because you will catch more grace than you can hold and you will have to pass on this joyous love of God to others. You will choose to leave things of this world that you have now in your life. You will be able to choose to be a disciple of Christ.

Quinto Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario

“Salgan a lo más profundo y bajen sus redes para la pesca.” Estas son las palabras dichas a Simón-Pedro y a sus compañeros después de una larga noche de pesca sin resultados. Pero con fe en Jesús, hacen lo que les dijo y se les da un milagro abundante de peces a estos pescadores. Ya que confiaban en Jesús, van y hacen lo que Él les ordena y estos pescadores obtienen una abundancia milagrosa de peces.

Cuando Simón es enfrentado con este grandioso milagro para él, la pesca, reacciona de una manera muy común. SE ARRODILLA Y LLORA: ¿Cuántas veces actuamos como Simón? Nos declaramos indignos de recibir la gracia de Dios, rechazando su misericordia, o ignoramos la presencia de Él y sus milagros en nuestras vidas. Simplemente lo llamamos buena suerte o lo descartamos como algo mundano.

Obviamente esto no está bien. Por ejemplo, ¿reconoces tú la presencia milagrosa de Cristo cada vez que tomas de Su mesa y comes? Cada domingo recibimos mucho más que una red llena de pescados.

De cualquier manera, Simón Pedro nos sirve a todos de ejemplo. El escucha a Jesús y lo sigue con confianza. Simón se convierte en un hombre de acción dejando atrás su trabajo de pescador para seguir la voluntad de Cristo “pescando hombres”.

Si seguimos el ejemplo de Simón Pedro, debemos confiar en Cristo y forzarnos a salir a las aguas más profundas, llenas de riesgos e incertidumbres; bajar las redes en búsqueda de lo que Cristo tiene dispuesto para nosotros. Una persona hace esto al recibir los sacramentos, leer las escrituras, participar en la comunidad, dedicar tiempo diariamente para la oración, y de muchas otras maneras más.

Esto ciertamente lleva riesgos porque pescaras mucha más gracia de la que puedes sostener, y tendrás que pasar este amor gozoso del Señor a los demás. Optarás por dejar atrás cosas de este mundo que tienes ahora en tu vida. Podrás elegir libremente ser un discípulo de Cristo.

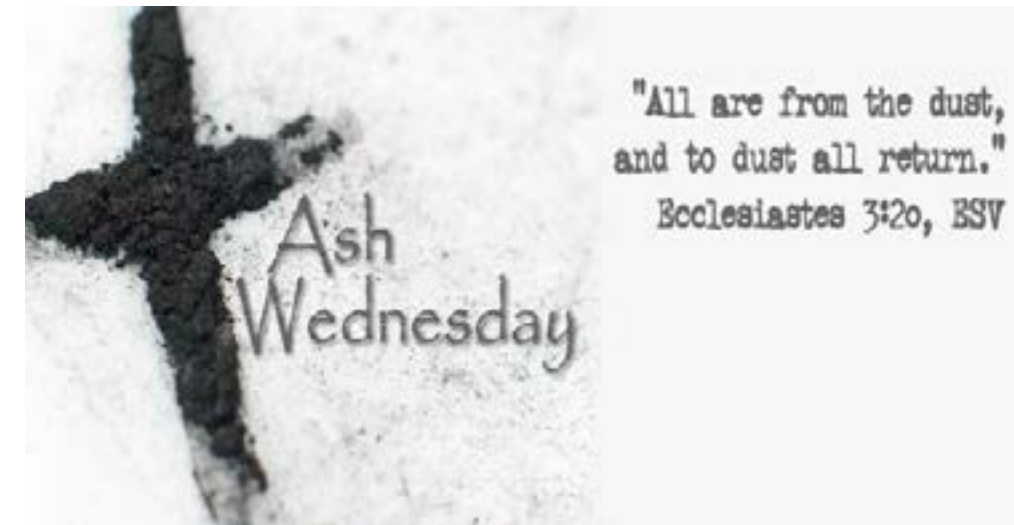

Garden of Carmel meeting will be on February 20- Saturday from 7:30 am Holy Mass followed by our meeting at the Library

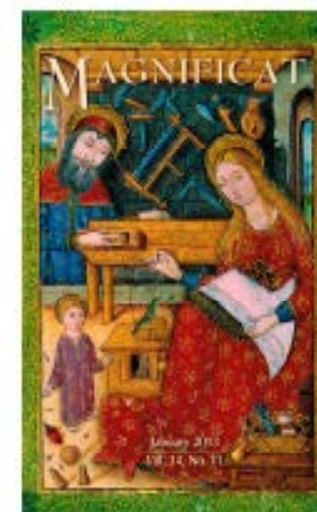
