

EASTER SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD

MARCH 27, 2016



THIS IS THE DAY THE LORD HAS MADE; LET US
REJOICE AND BE GLAD.

- PSALM 118

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Easter Sunday

The gospel reading for Easter Sunday places us at the empty tomb with Mary of Magdala, Simon Peter, and the disciple whom Jesus loved. It is interesting that the author does not name the other disciple whom Jesus loved as John, who we all assume is that person. Of course, tradition would also support the idea that the beloved disciple is John.

However, a close analysis of the text for the Gospel of John reveals that the beloved disciple is never named throughout the entire manuscript. There is a purposeful reason why the beloved disciple is not named. That reason, regardless of whether historically he was indeed John, is intended for our spiritual engagement. We are supposed to place ourselves in the story as the beloved disciple because we too stand at the entrance of the empty tomb. Most of us are not mystics like Paul who had the privilege of seeing Jesus in the full glory of the Resurrection; as a result, we must stand at the empty tomb and make a choice on whether or not we will believe in the Resurrection.

Independent of the bible, historians all agree that Jesus was a historical man who preached to the people, was crucified unjustly, and His tomb was found empty. The fact of His Resurrection is beyond the ability of historians to deal with or understand academically. Historians cannot accept the possibility of the Resurrection in the first place, because such an event is beyond history, physics, and world. The Resurrection is a divine and eternal reality. The academic discipline of history only studies the physical nature of the mortal world; academia does not include the transcendental or metaphysical realities of faith, even if those realities are manifested in the world. God is more and does more than can be studied by human academic disciplines.

Fortunately for us, we were created in the image of God allowing us to understand more and to be aware of the divine realities that the Lord manifests in the world. We are both body and spirit giving us the potential ability to live in the world and experience through faith the transcendent reality of God.

So, as people of faith, we stand at the empty tomb with a choice. Are we are going to be the beloved disciple accepting in faith the fact that Jesus rose from the tomb? By choosing not to believe, we reject the possible gift of eternity with God. If we choose to invest ourselves in the Resurrection, we will be elevated beyond the claws of death to the divine life with God in eternal bliss.

Domingo de Pascua

El Evangelio para este domingo de Pascua nos lleva a la tumba vacía junto con María de Mágdala, Simón Pedro y el discípulo amado de Jesús. Es interesante como el autor no nombra al discípulo amado de Jesús, que se presume es Juan ya que la tradición también apoya esta idea de que Juan es el discípulo amado.

Sin embargo, un análisis más detallado del Evangelio de Juan revela que al discípulo amado no se le nombra en ningún escrito de este Evangelio -- y esto es a propósito. La razón es, que sin importar si históricamente era realmente Juan o no, esta figura está ahí para envolvernos espiritualmente. A través de esta figura, nos colocamos nosotros dentro de la historia como el discípulo amado porque nosotros también estamos parados a la entrada de la tumba vacía. No somos místicos como Pablo que tuvo el privilegio de ver a Jesús en toda su gloria después de la resurrección, y es por eso que debemos pararnos frente a la tumba vacía y decidir si vamos a creer o no en la resurrección de Cristo.

Independientemente de lo que está en la Biblia, todos los historiadores están de acuerdo que Jesús fue un hombre que vivió en la historia, predicó al pueblo, fue crucificado injustamente, y su tumba fue descubierta vacía. La resurrección está más allá de la capacidad de los historiadores para comprender este hecho de un punto de vista académico; no pueden aceptar la posibilidad de que hubo una resurrección porque es un evento fuera del ámbito de la historia, la física, y la realidad del mundo. Los estudios académicos no incluyen las realidades transcendentales y metafísicas de la fe, aun cuando estas realidades se manifiesten en el mundo físico. Dios - y sus obras - son más de lo que pueden estudiar los humanos con sus disciplinas académicas.

Afortunadamente, hemos sido creados en la imagen de Dios y eso nos permite darnos cuenta y comprender un poco más las realidades divinas que Dios manifiesta en el mundo. Somos cuerpo y espíritu, y eso nos da la habilidad de poder vivir en el mundo mientras que experimentamos la realidad transcendental de Dios a través de nuestra fe.

Así que, como personas de fe, nos paramos frente a la tumba vacía con una decisión que tomar. ¿Seremos el discípulo amado aceptando con fe el hecho que Jesús resucitó de la tumba? ¿O elegimos no creer en esto, rechazando el posible regalo de una eternidad con Dios? Si elegimos involucrarnos en la resurrección, seremos elevados más allá de las garras de la muerte, hacia la vida divina con Dios en la felicidad eterna.
