Second Sunday of Easter

This Sunday, Jesus reveals himself to all the apostles, even to doubting Thomas—who finds it difficult to believe the resurrection. Thomas does not comprehend the perfection of Christ and the sanctification of the body. Often modern society takes on the doubt of Thomas, and we think that the resurrection is an impossibility. This doubt follows from a dualistic perspective of the world; it is the view that the spiritual world and life is separate from the physical world. This gives us the idea that we can live like Dr. Jekyll in terms of the spirit but let Mr. Hyde out when dealing with the world and moral activity.

Christ comes to Thomas to show his body filled with the wounds of his life so that this skepticism would be dispelled. In the resurrection, Jesus maintains his physical body communicating to us that we are to be perfected and sanctified both in our spirit and body. The Apostles do not understand this at first, and so Jesus comes to them and tells them, “Peace be with you” so as to assure them that the Father has sent to us the Holy Spirit to guide our mind and strengthen our bodies. Similar to Genesis when God breathes life into the clay, Jesus breathes divine life into their souls giving the Apostles the authority to forgive sin. That tremendous gift of love is unparalleled outside of the sacraments. In every sacrament, the glory of God is united to those who receive.

Take the opportunity this week to repent of our erroneous idea of separating the spirit from the body, going to our knees in humility to say “My Lord and my God” so that we might see and believe the resurrection of Christ. Christ’s divine life is made real to us in the Eucharist which is meant to be manifested and made visible to the world in and through our bodies each day and moment of our lives. The truth of Christ is revealed in the divine commission, which Christ has for us that “as the Father has sent me, so I send you.”

Segundo Domingo de Pascua

Este Domingo, Jesús se revela a todos los apóstoles, inclusive a Tomás el incrédulo a quien le es difícil creer en la resurrección. Tomás no comprende la perfección de Cristo y la santificación del cuerpo. La sociedad moderna suele tener la misma incredulidad de Tomás y creemos que la resurrección es algo imposible. Esta duda viene de una perspectiva dualista del mundo; es la perspectiva que el mundo y la vida espiritual es algo separado del mundo físico. Esto nos hace pensar que podemos actuar como una persona con dos caras -- a la Dr. Jekyll y Mr. Hyde – en cuanto a ser de una manera en cuanto al espíritu y de otra manera cuando se trata del mundo real y los asuntos morales.

Cristo va a Tomas para mostrarle su cuerpo lleno de heridas para que sus dudas se disipen. En la resurrección, Jesús mantiene su cuerpo físico para comunicarnos que debemos ser perfeccionados y santificados en espíritu y cuerpo. Al principio los apóstoles no entienden esto, es por eso que Cristo viene a ellos y les dice, “La Paz esté con ustedes”, para asegurarlos que el Padre nos ha enviado al Espíritu Santo para guiar nuestras mentes y fortalecer nuestros cuerpos. Como en el Génesis cuando Dios sopla nueva vida en el barro, Jesús sopla la vida divina en las almas de los apóstoles, dándoles la autoridad de perdonar pecados. Ese tremendo regalo de amor no tiene paralelo fuera de los sacramentos. En cada sacramento, la gloria de Dios se une a los que la reciben.

Tomen la oportunidad esta semana de arrepentirse de esa idea equivocada de separar el espíritu del cuerpo, arrodillándose con humildad diciendo, “¡Señor mío y Dios mío!” para que podamos ver y creer en la resurrección de Cristo. La vida divina de Cristo se convierte real en la Eucaristía que sirve para manifestarse y hacerse visible al mundo en y a través de nuestros cuerpos cada día y a cada momento de nuestras vidas. La verdad de Cristo se nos revela en el encargo divino que Cristo nos da que es, “Como el Padre me ha enviado, así también los envío yo.”

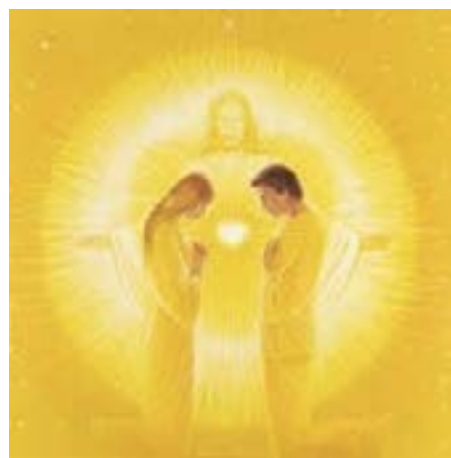

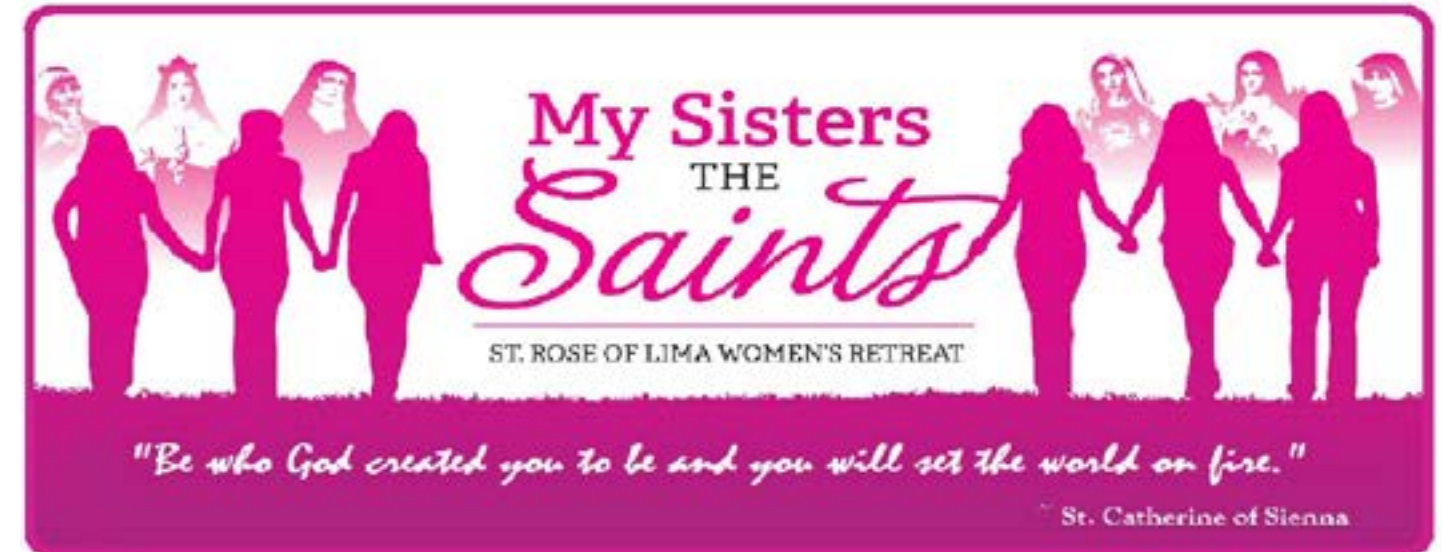
