Fourth Sunday of Easter

This Sunday has been designated by the universal Church as the "World Day of Prayer for Vocations." What does this mean to you? Often people think this means that the Church is asking for men to join the priesthood (or at least consider living in a religious community) Rarely do people realize that a prayer for vocations is for all of us. Vocation comes from the Latin word "vocare" meaning "to call" or "to name." When the Church uses the word vocation it applies to each and every one of us. The Father calls us forth individually to live holy lives in order to be named in Christ's flock, filling the kingdom of God. The challenge for each one of us is to hear Christ's call and to go to him.

In the gospel it is this call of vocation which is being described. When a shepherd brings the flock into the fold for the night, often the animals are corralled in with other sheep. In the morning the shepherd calls out to his sheep and the sheep, knowing their shepherds voice and call, will come out of the fold to the shepherd. The Shepherd cares for the sheep by taking them to pasture, showing them where to go, and protecting them.

In the same way, we are in the world with many different people of political, ethnic, economic, and religious backgrounds; however, we are being called out by Christ, the Good Shepherd, to be His lambs in His care. The sheep will follow the shepherd because they trust and know the call of their shepherd. Do you know and trust the call of the Good Shepherd? To follow the Good Shepherd is to put your life in the hands of God, trying to live each day holy. During this World Day of Prayer for Vocations, listen to Christ and follow his voice so that you can be named a son or daughter of God.

We pray to our Lord Jesus,

Through the intercession of our patron saints, San Diego, Our Lady of Refuge, and Saint Rose of Lima,

We beg you for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon all of us called to be your disciples and members of your Church.

Bless us to be obedient servants as you were obedient in loving response to the Father's love, and to love one another as you have first loved us.

Bless us with happy marriages and holy families, with bishops, religious, deacons and priests to image your presence among us, and with dedicated lay people, both married and single, to be signs of your love in the world.

Help us to embrace the mission you have entrusted to us, in lives of fidelity, holiness and compassion.

San Diego, pray for us... Our Lady of Refuge, pray for us... Saint Rose of Lima, pray for us...

Cuarto Domingo de Pascua

La Iglesia universal ha designado este domingo como la "Jornada Mundial de Oración por las Vocaciones". ¿Qué significa esto para ti? Muchas veces la gente piensa que esto quiere decir que la Iglesia está buscando hombres para que entren al sacerdocio (o por lo menos consideren vivir en una comunidad religiosa), pero raramente se da cuenta la gente que una oración por las vocaciones es una oración para todos nosotros. La palabra vocación viene del Latín, "vocare", que significa "llamar" o "nombrar". Cuando la iglesia usa esta palabra, la aplica a cada uno de nosotros. EL Padre nos llama individualmente a vivir vidas santas para poder ser parte del rebaño de Cristo, y llenar el Reino de Dios. El reto es que cada uno de nosotros escuche el llamado de Cristo y caminemos hacia Él.

El evangelio describe este llamado a la vocación. Cuando el pastor trae a su rebaño a su redil para pasar la noche, hay otros animales en el corral con las ovejas. A la mañana siguiente el pastor le llama sus ovejas y ellas, conociendo la voz del pastor, salen del redil hacia él. El pastor cuida a sus ovejas llevándolas a la pastura, enseñándoles por dónde ir, y protegiéndolas.

De la misma manera, nosotros estamos en un mundo lleno de personas diferentes, de varios orígenes políticos, económicos y religiosos; sin embargo, Cristo, el Buen Pastor, nos está llamando a ser sus ovejas bajo su cuidado. Las ovejas van a seguir al pastor porque confían en él y conocen su llamado. ¿Conoces tú el llamado del Buen Pastor y confías en él? Seguir al Buen Pastor es poner tu vida en las manos de Dios, tratando de vivir cada día de una manera santa. Durante esta Jornada Mundial de Oración por las Vocaciones, escucha la voz de Cristo y síguela para que puedas ser llamado un hijo o hija de Dios.

Señor Jesús,

Por la intercesión de nuestros santos patronos, San Diego, Nuestra Señora del Refugio, y Santa Rosa de Lima,

Te pedimos que derrames tu Espíritu Santo sobre todos nosotros llamados a ser tus discípulos y miembros de tu Iglesia.

Bendícenos para que seamos servidores obedientes, como tú fuiste obediente en respuesta amorosa al amor del Padre, y para que nos amemos unos a otros como tú nos has amado desde el principio.

Bendícenos con matrimonios felices y familias santas, con obispos, religiosos, diáconos y sacerdotes que representen tu presencia entre nosotros, y con laicos dedicados, casados y solteros, que sean señales de tu amor en el mundo.

Ayúdanos para que aceptemos la misión que nos has confiado, en vidas de fidelidad, santidad y compasión.




