## Sixth Sunday of Easter

Approaching the end of the Easter season at Pentecost, we Christ's people—His body, His Church—continue His mission on earth. In the scriptures, Christ prepares His disciples for life in the world as He returns to the Father. The relationship between Christ and His disciples, which analogously refers to the church, will be dramatically changed with His return to the Father in the Ascension and the arrival of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. These disciples—who have had serious difficulty in understanding and following Jesus while he lived among them—are now being promoted in God's Kingdom to be His hands and feet among us, teaching truth, and leading the Church in the world. This task entrusted to the disciples is an impossible task for them, and they knew it. How would they be able to follow the will of God?

It is for this reason that Jesus gives to the disciples His succession of authority, power, and understanding; His "peace". What is this peace he gives? It is His Love for the Father and the wonderful Love exchange that occurs between Him and the Father, whose name is Holy Spirit. It is by living in that Love and the exchange of the Holy Spirit with Christ and others that we can have His Peace. By dwelling in His Peace and sharing it as we are meant to do during mass, we lovingly support fellow disciples of Christ in the Church. We invite others to Christ by our example of God's presence in us, and we inspire the spiritually dead to come to the vine so as to be truly attached to Christ and live in the Spirit with us. Christ is telling them and us that we are to Love like Him; from a full abandonment to the Love given to us from the Father, to the Son, and manifested by the Holy Spirit through ministry of the Church in our assembly.

It is for this reason in the Acts of the Apostles that a letter and specific representatives were sent to the Gentile cities to clearly explain the teachings of the Church. It is important that we follow and believe what has been given to us from God through an unbroken chain of representation, or apostolic succession. What comes from God cannot be created by human beings; we can only accept and give that which is godly from God. This important principle is as important today as it was in biblical times. So often popular ideas arise about God, morality, and the rules of Church that originate in entertainment and imagination which we end up believing in. Such belief can dramatically affect the course of our lives. When it comes to understanding the faith it is ok to discuss your thoughts with others, but understand that the truth is best clarified through consultation with a priest or other religious, whose lives are dedicated to Christ. Ultimately, here in the Diocese of San Diego, it is our Bishop Robert McElroy—who is the apostolic representative of Christ—who is the most important person to listen to in order to understand the faith in our local Church.

## Sexto Domingo de Pascua

Al acercarnos más al final de la temporada de Pascua con la observación de Pentecostés, nosotros como el pueblo de Cristo – Su Cuerpo, Su Iglesia – continuamos Su misión aquí en la tierra. En las lecturas, Cristo prepara a sus discípulos a vivir en el mundo mientras que El regresa al Padre. La relación entre Cristo y sus discípulos, que de forma análoga se aplica a la Iglesia, será cambiada drásticamente con el regreso de Cristo a su Padre en la Ascensión y con la venida del Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés. Los discípulos – que han batallado con comprender y seguir a Jesús mientras que Él vivía entre ellos – ahora están siendo ascendidos a ser las manos y pies del Reino de Dios entre nosotros, enseñando la fe y estableciendo la Iglesia en este mundo. Esta tarea es algo casi imposible para ellos, y ellos lo saben. ¿Cómo podrán seguir la voluntad de Dios?

Es por esta misma razón que Jesús les da a sus discípulos su sucesión de autoridad, poder y comprensión; su "paz". ¿Cuál es la paz que Él da? Es Su amor por el Padre y el maravilloso intercambio de amor que existe entre Él y el Padre, que se llama el Espíritu Santo. Es al vivir dentro de ese amor y dentro del intercambio del Espíritu Santo con Cristo y los demás que podemos tener Su paz. Al vivir en Su paz y compartirla como se espera de nosotros durante la misa, apoyamos con nuestro amor a los discípulos de Cristo en la Iglesia. Invitamos a los demás a conocer a Cristo por nuestro ejemplo de la presencia de Dios en nosotros, e inspiramos a los que están espiritualmente muertos a venir a la viña para que se conecten verdaderamente con Cristo y vivan también como nosotros en el Espíritu. Cristo les dice a sus discípulos y a nosotros que debemos amar como Él -- abandonarnos completamente al amor que nos da el Padre, el Hijo, y que manifiesta el Espíritu Santo a través del ministerio de la Iglesia.

Es por esta razón que en los Hechos de los Apóstoles, hubo cartas y representantes específicos que fueron enviados a las ciudades Gentiles para explicar claramente las enseñanzas de la Iglesia. Es importante que sigamos y creamos en los que se nos ha dado de parte de Dios por medio de una cadena ininterrumpida de representación; de sucesión apostólica. Lo que viene de Dios no puede ser creado por los humanos; solo podemos aceptar y dar lo que viene de Dios. Este principio es tan importante hoy en día como lo era en tiempos bíblicos. Muchas veces surgen ideas populares acerca de Dios, la moralidad y las reglas de la Iglesia que tienen origen en diversión e imaginación y terminamos por creerlas, pero estas ideas pueden afectar dramáticamente el curso de nuestras vidas. Cuando se trata de comprender nuestra fe, es bueno consultar con otros pero comprendan que la mejor manera de aclarar la verdad es consultando a un sacerdote u otro religioso que ha dedicado su vida a Cristo. En última instancia, aquí en la Diócesis de San Diego es nuestro Obispo, Robert McElroy - el representante apostólico de Cristo – que es la persona más importante que debemos escuchar para comprender la fe en nuestra iglesia local.

Homeless Meal has been changed from Wed to Thursday's. The meal will be served at the corner of Woodlawn and F Street in one of the city warehouse. For those of you who are not familiar with the workings of this program, it was started 15-16 years ago, by the South Bay Ecumenical Council. Sr. Joan King was a big part of the Council, and Sr. Dolores, was in charge of getting people to cook and serve the meal. The panel consisted of several South Bay churches. These churches still take a turn at serving a hot meal. There are 13 churches involved and we each take a turn every three months. Because of the generosity of our St. Rose Parish we are able to make and package a lunch for the folks to take with them after they have their hot meal. This makes sure that they have a meal for breakfast the next day. St. Rose is known by all of the participants as being one of the most generous. Though we can get food from the storage which South Bay Community Services keeps, we always have more than enough donations. Rarely have we had to use any commodities from their cache of food. You are encouraged to watch the bulletin for dates of service. **Our next date will be Thursday June 9th.** We always serve on the second Thursday of the month. I do hope those of you who have helped in the past will not find this change to difficult.

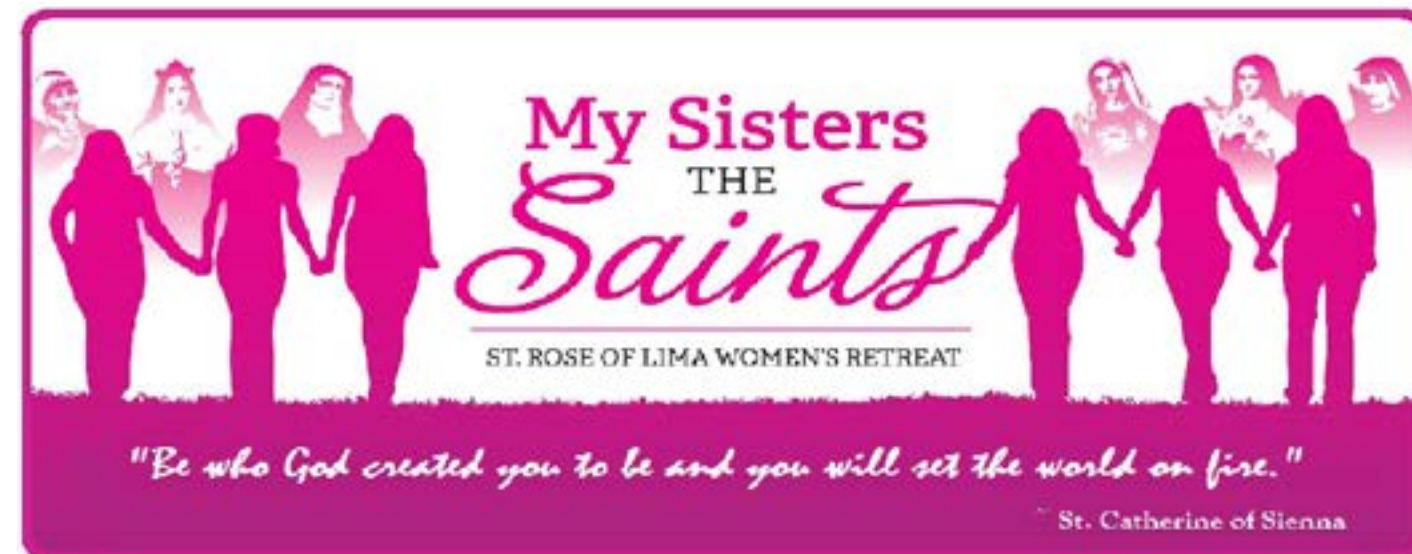
