## Pentecost

In the first reading from Acts of the Apostles, the coming of the Holy Spirit is symbolized by tongues of fire. Of course, the symbolism represents the Apostles being inspired by the Holy Spirit to preach the Word of God so as to bring about the great conversion in Jerusalem; however, the tongues of fire have a deeper meaning rooted in the Old Testament and human experience. Fire itself is basic to the human experience. Imagine civilization without fire . . . Without fire our food would be cold, steaks would not be as appetizing, we would not be able to heat our homes, and we wouldn't even have electricity and the basics of modern life. The Ancients understood that fire and our ability to control fire was a gift from God allowing humanity to grow beyond an animal state and share a little in divine power. Fire is the foundation of human activity and life.

Tongues of fire descended upon the Apostles, empowering them to preach the Word of God and be agents of the Holy Spirit; that same Holy Spirit who brings the Word of God to us establishes the greatest power of all for humanity, the fiery life of God. Soon, our bishop will give the sacrament of Confirmation to several young men and women in the parish, and those individuals will receive the same Holy Spirit represented by the tongues of fire. These newly confirmed will have the power of fire in their hearts. Pray that they will use that fire to heat and warm the faith of others in order to continue building the eternal Kingdom of God.

Any of you who are not baptized and confirmed . . . what are you waiting for? The Apocalypse? Register at the office before it is too late.

And for those of us who have been baptized and confirmed: Are you letting the Holy Spirit burn in your heart? Are you seeking to grow in your faith and to share the gospel? All of us who are confirmed are commissioned like the Apostles to be agents of Christ. Each of us here is called to do our part in building up that Kingdom of God. How are you fulfilling this?

## Pentecostés

En la primera lectura de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, la venida del Espíritu Santo se representa con lenguas de fuego. Este simbolismo representa a los Apóstoles siendo inspirados por el Espíritu Santo a predicar la palabra de Dios para lograr la gran conversión de Jerusalén. Pero además, las lenguas de fuego tienen un significado más profundo basado en el Antiguo Testamento y la experiencia humana. El fuego en si es fundamental a la experiencia humana. Imagínense lo que sería la civilización sin el fuego.... alimentos fríos, un bistec no sería tan apetecedor, no estarían calientes nuestros hogares, ni tendrían electricidad, ni las necesidades básicas de la vida moderna. Como pueden apreciar, este año se está convirtiendo muy difícil financieramente. Los gastos han sido más de lo esperado en los últimos seis meses y la colecta ha sido menos de lo esperado. Desafortunadamente, las proyecciones del presupuesto para el año entrante serán aún más difíciles. Cabe mencionar que, aunque algunos de los gastos más grandes han sido por el mejoramiento del sonido en la iglesia y en el salón parroquial, también los gastos han sido por simples reparaciones que son aparentes; las colectas son muy pocas para sostener una parroquia como esta. Ciertamente, solo 750 de 6,000 familias registradas, dan una donación de \$4.00 a la semana. En realidad, solo 750 de 6,000 familias registradas, entregan sus sobres con la donación de \$24.00.

Dear Parishioners,

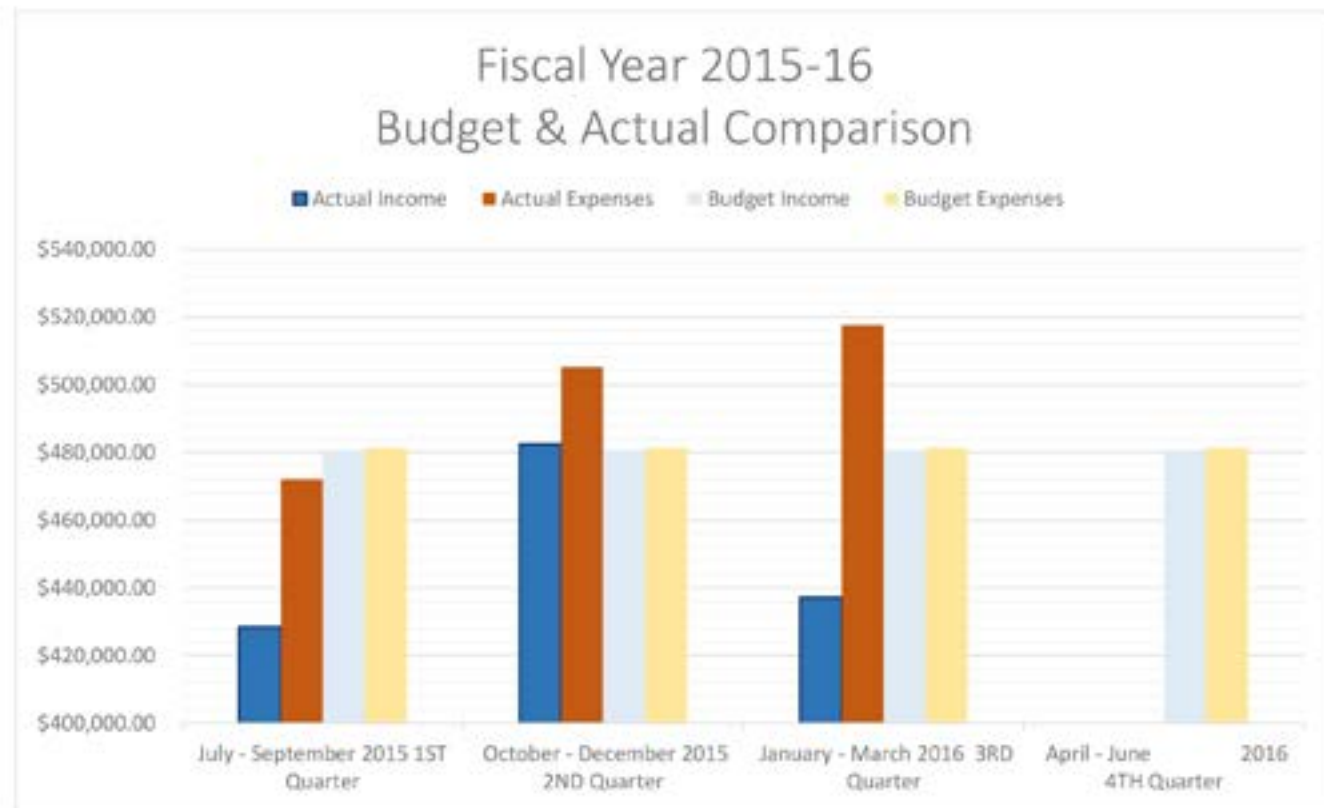
As can be seen, this year is turning out to be rough financially. Expenses have been greater than expected in the last six months and collections have been less than anticipated. Unfortunately, budget projections for next year are even more difficult. Even though some of the greater expenses are due to improvements to the sound system in the Church, Hall, and repairs a simple fact has become apparent; collections are too low to sustain a parish of this size. Consider that for a parish population of 6,000 families, the average donation is only \$4.00 per week. In reality, only 750 families, out of 6,000 families registered, turn in envelopes with an average donation of \$24.00.

I need your help to simply fulfill our current obligations as a parish. I am asking every parishioner to join me by increasing how much you give each week by \$5 to \$10 dollars. I am also increasing my weekly donation by \$10 dollars so that what I ask of you, I am doing.

**Feeding of the Homeless & Indigent**

Important date change Homeless Meal has been changed from Wed to Thursday's. The meal will be served at the corner of Woodlawn and F Street in one of the city warehouse.

For those of you who are not familiar with the workings of this program, it was started 15-16 years ago, by the South Bay Ecumenical Council. Sr. Joan King was a big part of the Council, and Sr. Dolores, was in charge of getting people to cook and serve the meal. The panel consisted of several South Bay churches. These churches still take a turn at serving a hot meal. There are 13 churches involved and we each take a turn every three months. Because of the generosity of our St. Rose Parish we are able to make and package a lunch for the folks to take with them after they have their hot meal. This makes sure that they have a meal for breakfast the next day. St. Rose is known by all of the participants as being one of the most generous. Though we can get food from the storage which South Bay Community Services keeps, we always have more than enough donations. Rarely have we had to use any commodities from their cache of food. You are encouraged to watch the bulletin for dates of service. Our next date will be Thursday June 9th. We always serve on the second Thursday of the month. I do hope those of you who have helped in the past will not find this change to difficult. More updates coming with regard to distribution of commodities on Wednesdays.
