## The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

This Sunday we will celebrate the feast of "Corpus Christi" in order to honor the sacred Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ given to us in the Eucharist. This feast is intended to help us comprehend the Incarnation of Jesus and its many dimensions. Not only is the Incarnation apparent in the Annunciation and Nativity; but it also occurs at Consecration during every Mass. Christ is made real to us at the altar in His Body and Blood through the Eucharistic celebration; by our reception of His Body and Blood we are transformed into that same reality. We become Christ for the world. However, do we embrace this truth in actually offering ourselves as Christ, doing his work?

What evidence do we have in the world that exemplifies Christians doing the work of Christ? Let us consider that the Church is responsible for the existence of the first hospitals, the preservation of knowledge by the monasteries during the Dark Ages, the removal of slavery in western societies, and the great charitable efforts of religious communities such as the Sisters of Charity. However, in modern times, a worrisome trend has occurred. An internal erosion of basic Christian values has taken place. As Christians, we have allowed worldly values to grab a hold on our hearts, minds, and actions in relation to the principles of "Life", "Marriage", and "Conscience". If this evil trend continues, we will implode, destroying society, this nation, and ourselves.

However, hope has not been lost. God is on our side and our faith in Christ will lead us out of the slavery of Egypt, through the difficult discipline of the desert, and to the joyful promised land of freedom.

Each of us, as individuals, needs to reevaluate our principles and identity:

- Do we stand for the civil rights of all people living in this nation? Or, do some lives have less value because they are too young, too old, or not productive enough?
- Do we stand for marriage as a sacred, discipline-building, and protecting Sacrament, transforming human society for the common good? Or is marriage simply a human-imagined institution of which its definition can be changeable depending on the cultural fad?

## Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo

Este domingo observamos la fiesta de "Corpus Christi" en honor del santísimo cuerpo y sangre de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo que se nos da en la Eucaristía. No solo es aparente la encarnación en la Anunciación y la Natividad, sino también ocurre durante la Consagración en cada misa. Cristo se convierte en algo real para nosotros en el altar, por medio de su cuerpo y sangre en la celebración Eucarística. Al recibir nosotros su cuerpo y sangre, nos transformamos dentro de esa realidad, nos convertimos en Cristo para el mundo. Sin embargo, ¿cumplimos con esta realidad realmente ofreciéndonos como Cristo, haciendo su labor?

¿Que evidencia hay en el mundo que nos muestra como los Cristianos han estado haciendo la labor de Cristo? Tenemos ejemplos de hospitales fundados por la iglesia, de los monasterios en la Edad Media que servían para conservar los conocimientos, de la erradicación de la esclavitud en el mundo occidental, de los grandes esfuerzos caritativos de comunidades religiosas como las Madres de la Caridad. Pero en la época moderna ha surgido una tendencia preocupante. Hay una erosión interior de valores Cristianos. Como cristianos hemos permitido que los valores materiales invadan nuestros corazones, mentes y acciones en cuanto a los principios de "Vida", "Matrimonio", y "Consciencia". Si sigue esta tendencia xxx, va a derrumbar nuestra sociedad, este país y a nosotros mismos

No hay que perder esperanza. Dios esta de nuestra parte, y nuestra fe en Cristo nos sacara de la esclavitud de Egipto, a través de la disciplina difícil del desierto, y hacia la gran tierra prometida de la liberad.

Cada uno de nosotros, como individuos, tenemos que reconsiderar nuestros principios y nuestra identidad:

- ¿Defendemos los derechos civiles de todos los habitantes de este país? - O le damos menos valor a ciertas vidas porque están demasiado jóvenes, demasiado viejos, o no son tan productivos?
- ¿Defendemos el matrimonio como una disciplina sagrada que protege la sociedad humana por el bien mayor? - O vemos el matrimonio simplemente como una institución humana imaginaria que es cambiante según las tendencias populares?

The feast of Corpus Christi challenges us to take seriously the issues of our nation today. Christ instituted the Eucharist for the Church during the Last Supper with those most memorable words: *“Take this, all of you, and drink from it, for this is the Chalice of my Blood, the Blood of the new and eternal covenant, which will be poured out for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Do this in memory of me.”* Jesus showed us the Christian approach for facing the problems of this world; we are to sacrifice ourselves for the lives of others according to God’s moral standards even with our personal struggles and difficulties. Jesus spilled His Blood for our eternal salvation, which we receive at Mass. We too need to commit our effort and spill our blood for God, His standards, and all people.

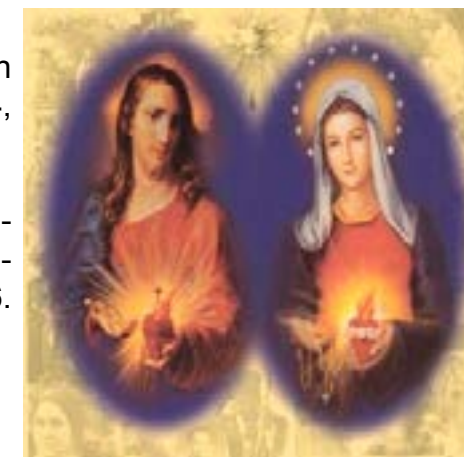

Dear Parishioners,

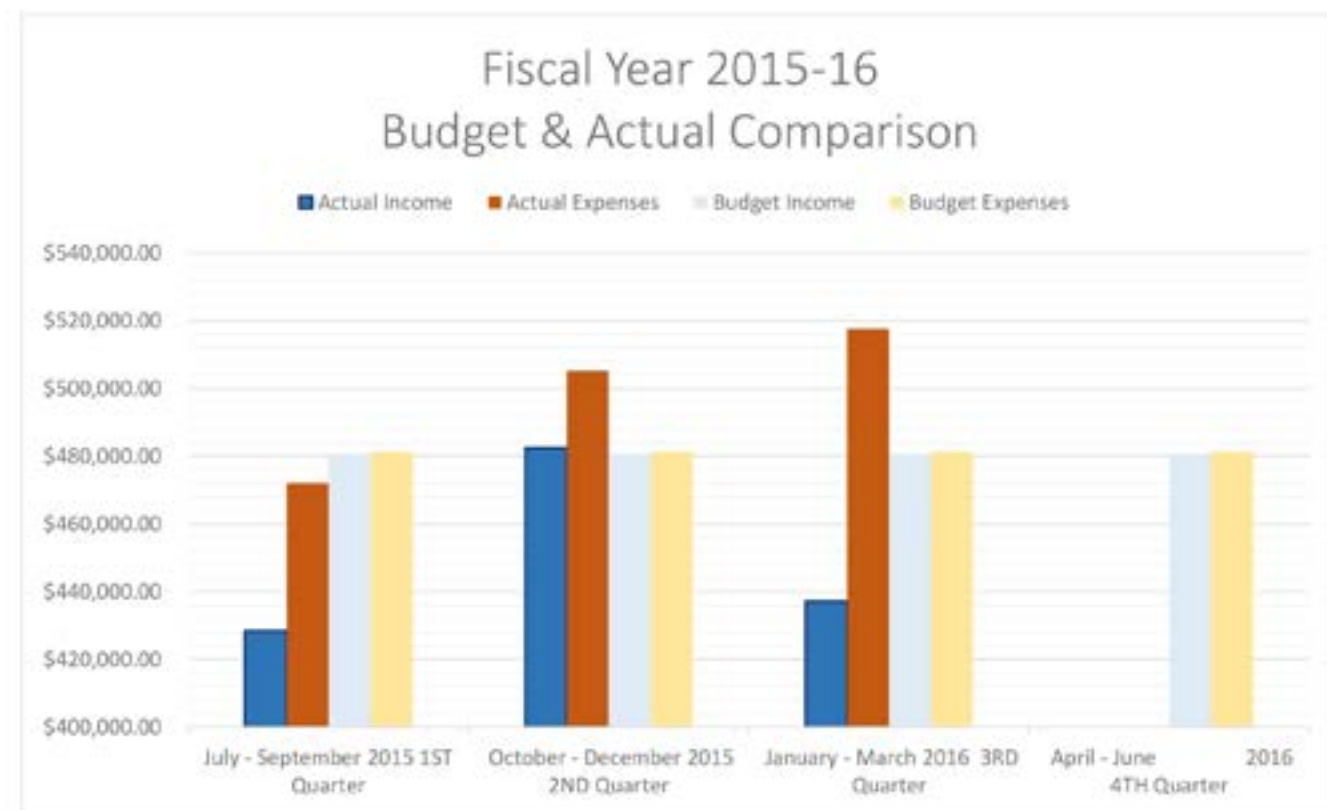
As can be seen, this year is turning out to be rough financially. Expenses have been greater than expected in the last six months and collections have been less than anticipated. Unfortunately, budget projections for next year are even more difficult. Even though some of the greater expenses are due to improvements to the sound system in the Church, Hall, and repairs a simple fact has become apparent; collections are too low to sustain a parish of this size. Consider that for a parish population of 6,000 families, the average donation is only \$4.00 per week. In reality, only 750 families, out of 6,000 families registered, turn in envelopes with an average donation of \$24.00.

I need your help to simply fulfill our current obligations as a parish. I am asking every parishioner to join me by increasing how much you give each week by \$5 to \$10 dollars. I am also increasing my weekly donation by \$10 dollars so that what I ask of you, I am doing.
