Eleventh Sunday of Ordinary Time

This 11th Sunday of Ordinary time, we turn inward to analyze the hypocrisy humanity seems to indulge in most often. In the first reading, King David has lusted over and committed adultery with Bathsheba, the wife of a loyal and trusted officer of his army. In response to Bathsheba becoming pregnant, King David tries to hide his sin. The consequence he chooses from his infidelity and shame is to have his loyal officer killed.

In the portion of the story proclaimed at mass, the prophet Nathan confronts King David about his sin, and King David humbly admits his fault and repents. King David severely sins multiple times in his life but his great contribution to our spiritual life is that he shows us an example of self reflection followed by sincere repentance.

We must ask ourselves: Are we like the Pharisees in the gospel who judge others and condemn others based upon their status, ethnic origin, financial capability, or where they live? Or do we cause scandal and harm because people are not behaving the way one wants them to? Judgment of others is a reflection of a person's failure to be honest about one's own self and sin.

Christ challenges us to look inside ourselves this Sunday in order to find our own sins and faults, to humble ourselves, and turn to the Father for mercy, so as to root out our hypocrisy of criticizing others and ignoring our own faults. We are to sincerely seek humility so that we might deal with our neighbors fairly and grow spiritually towards Christ.

Undécimo Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario

Este onceavo domingo de Tiempo Ordinario, reflexionamos sobre una hipocresía que la humanidad tiende a cometer con mucha frecuencia. En la primera lectura leemos acerca del Rey David deseando y cometiendo adulterio con Betsabé, la esposa de un oficial leal y confiable de su ejército. Cuando Betsabé sale encinta, el Rey David intenta ocultar su pecado. La consecuencia que elije para ocultar su infidelidad y desgracia es mandar matar a su oficial leal.

En la parte del relato que se lee durante la misa, el profeta Natán enfrenta al Rey David acerca de este pecado, y el Rey admite humildemente su culpa y se arrepiente. El Rey David comete graves pecados varias veces durante su vida pero su gran contribución a nuestra vida espiritual es que nos muestra el ejemplo de la auto-reflexión y el verdadero arrepentimiento.

Debemos preguntarnos: ¿Somos como los Fariseos en el evangelio que juzgan a los demás y los condenan según su status social, origen étnico, posición financiera o vivienda? ¿Causamos escándalo y daño porque la gente no se comporta de la manera que nosotros deseamos? El juzgar a otros refleja la falla de una persona de ser honrado consigo mismo y sus pecados.

Cristo nos reta este domingo a ver nuestro interior para encontrar nuestros propios pecados y faltas, reflejar sobre cómo criticamos a los demás mientras que ignoramos nuestras propias fallas. Debemos buscar la humildad con sinceridad para que podamos tratar al prójimo de manera justa y acercarnos espiritualmente a Cristo.
