Twelfth Sunday of Ordinary Time

In the gospel this Sunday, Jesus asks the disciples the question, "Who do you say that I am?" Compared to the response of the crowds, Peter answers well that Jesus is the "Christ of God", essentially meaning that Jesus is the anointed Lord for the people of God. Then Jesus explains to them that the crowds are not yet ready to understand what being a Lord of God's Kingdom means. The Lord of the Kingdom of God accepts the suffering of self sacrifice for the good of others so that the truth of the resurrection can be revealed. In the end, the demand Jesus makes is that once he has gone to the cross and has been raised, then the truth of who he is is revealed. And this revelation demands from us the offering of our own lives for the Gospel so as to save the lives of others and ourselves. For his commitment to this, Peter is crucified upside down in Rome. Are you this committed?

In this modern day of cell phones, e-mail, and all things electronic, the National Security Agency has caused a scandal in the last few years. We are all a little nervous that "Big Brother" is observing, filtering, and simply knowing what we are communicating in our business and private lives. Liberals and Conservatives alike question whether the NSA program is a violation of our constitutional right to privacy.

The question I have for us Catholics is: When an NSA agent is looking through your electronic activity, would that agent recognize you as a Catholic? Jesus' question of "Who do you say I am" and "Who do others say I am" is really a question we should ask ourselves. Who would people recognize us to be? Would our electronic activity be any different than the ungodly in the world? Or, would the NSA agent know quickly through your correspondence that you are a faithful follower of Christ preparing and living like our Lord? Do you proclaim the gospel in your life each and every day?

Doceavo Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario

En el Evangelio de este Domingo, Jesús le pregunta a los discípulos, "¿Quién dice la gente que soy yo?" A diferencia de la respuesta de la multitud, Pedro responde correctamente que Jesús es el "Mesías de Dios", que significa esencialmente que Jesús es el ungido del Señor para el pueblo de Dios. Jesús continúa, explicándoles que la multitud aún no está lista para comprender lo que significa ser el Mesías del Reino de Dios. El Mesías del Reino de Dios acepta el sufrimiento de auto-sacrificio por el bien de otros para que la verdad de la resurrección sea revelada. Y esta revelación exige de nosotros que ofrezcamos nuestras propias vidas por el Evangelio para poder salvar nuestras vidas y las de los demás. A Pedro lo crucificaron cabeza abajo en Roma por comprometerse a ofrecer su vida por esto. ¿Estás tú igual de comprometido?

En esta era moderna de celulares, e-mail, y todo electrónico, la Agencia Nacional de Seguridad (NSA) ha causado escándalo en los últimos años poniendo a la gente nerviosa que el "Gran Hermano" está observando, filtrando, y simplemente enterándose de lo que comunicamos en nuestras vidas profesionales y privadas. Tanto la gente de tendencias liberales como los de tendencias conservadoras cuestionan si la NSA está en violación de nuestro derecho constitucional a la privacidad.

La pregunta que tengo para nosotros los católicos, es: ¿Si un agente de la NSA busca en tu actividad electrónica, te reconocería como alguien Católico? Las preguntas que hace Jesús, "Ustedes, ¿quién dicen que soy yo?" Y "¿Quién dice la gente que soy yo?", realmente son preguntas que nos debemos de hacer a nosotros mismos. ¿Cómo nos identificaría el agente? ¿Sería nuestra actividad electrónica realmente diferente a lo impío que hay en el mundo? ¿O sabría el agente del NSA rápidamente por medio de nuestra correspondencia que somos seguidores fieles de Cristo, viviendo como nuestro Señor? ¿Proclamas tú el Evangelio en tu vida todos los días?
