Seventeenth Sunday of Ordinary Time

The Gospel this Sunday calls us to listen to the very core of Christianity by remembering the specifics of the Lord's Prayer. These are the words which Jesus spoke, and the method of how we are to pray.

We are to begin by crying out, from who we are, to say that the Father's very name is holy and His glory is much greater than all things. "*Father, hallowed be your name . . .*"

We are to recognize that His reign is supreme and that the world is being transformed into exactly what God desires it to be. We have the freedom to be a part of His kingdom which exists for all time or not. "*. . . Your kingdom come . . .*"

We are to realize the world and each of us exist at the pleasure of Father's goodness and mercy; so, we beg the Creator to continue to give the sun each morning, to give us our nutrition, and to sustain our existence each and every day. "*. . . Give us each day our daily Bread . . .*"

And while on our knees, we beg for mercy and pardon from our weakness, selfishness, pride, and general stupidity. All of us, do what we ought not do for reasons that are never good enough. "*. . . and forgive us our sins . . .*"

Up to this point in the prayer, we have been speaking about the Father or what we want from the father, but now we stand up and grab a hold of the challenge to forgive. We qualify the mercy that the Father is to give us in his pardon. We are to reflect Christ in forgiveness to those who have wronged us. We forgive not for the wrongdoer, because he deserves our pardon; but for the sake of mercy—a mercy from us to them and a call to the Father in order to give us that same merciful pardon. "*. . . For we ourselves forgive everyone in debt to us . . .*"

And finally, a plea to the Father to have pity on us so that we might not be tested to prove our love and loyalty, recognizing that we are weak and might fail. "*. . . and do not subject us to the final test . . .*"

We need but one thing: God dwelling within us. By asking for and giving mercy and pardon to our brothers, sisters, neighbors, strangers, and enemies, we open our souls to the dwelling of the Holy Spirit within us. It is the Holy Spirit dwelling within that gives us true purpose and life. The Father will not deny us His Spirit. He gives Himself freely in the Holy Spirit and does so without forcing Himself upon us. We must persistently ask for the ability to accept that divine gift.

Décimo Séptimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Este domingo el Evangelio nos llama a escuchar, desde la esencia misma del cristianismo a recordar lo específico de la oración del Señor. Estas son las palabras que Jesús mencionó y el método de cómo debemos hacer oración.

Debemos empezar gritando a partir de quienes somos, para decir que, el nombre del Padre es Santo y Su gloria es mucho más grande que todas las cosas. "*Padre, santificado sea tu nombre . . .*"

Hemos de reconocer que su reino es supremo y que, el mundo se está transformado en exactamente lo que Dios quiere que sea. Tenemos la libertad de ser parte o no de Su reino que todo el tiempo ha existido. "*. . . Venga a nosotros tu reino . . .*"

Estamos para darnos cuenta de que, el mundo y cada uno de nosotros, existe por la voluntad del Padre, por su bondad y misericordia; entonces, roguemos al Creador que continúe dándonos el sol cada mañana, que alimente y mantenga nuestra existencia todos los días. "*. . . Danos hoy nuestro pan de cada día . . .*"

Y mientras de rodillas, roguemos por la misericordia y el perdón de nuestras debilidades, por nuestros egoísmos, por nuestro orgullo y por nuestras tonterías en general. Todos nosotros hacemos lo que no debemos hacer por motivos que jamás son lo suficientemente buenos. "*. . . y perdona nuestros pecados . . .*"

Hasta aquí en la oración hemos estado hablando del Padre o de lo que queremos de Él, ahora, mantengámonos de pie y tomemos el desafío de perdonar. Consideremos la misericordia que el Padre nos da en su perdón. Debemos de reflejar a Cristo perdonando a los que nos han hecho mal. Perdonemos, no por el malhechor si no porque, merece nuestro perdón; por la misericordia – misericordia de nosotros hacia ellos y una señal al Padre para que, nos de el mismo perdón misericordioso. "*. . . así como también nosotros perdonamos a los que nos ofenden. . .*"

Por último, una suplica al Padre para que tenga piedad de nosotros y que nuestro amor y lealtad no sean puestos a prueba, reconociendo que somos débiles y podemos fallar. "*. . . no nos dejes caer en tentación . . .*"

Solo una cosa necesitamos: que Dios habite en nosotros. Pidiendo y dando la misericordia y perdonando a nuestros hermanos, vecinos, extraños y enemigos abrimos nuestras almas a la morada del Espíritu Santo en nosotros. Es la morada del Espíritu Santo en nosotros que nos da verdadero propósito y la vida. El Padre no nos negará su Espíritu. Él se da libremente en el Espíritu Santo y lo hace sin forzarse a Sí mismo para nosotros. Debemos persistentemente pedir por la gracia de aceptar este regalo divino.

Christmas in July

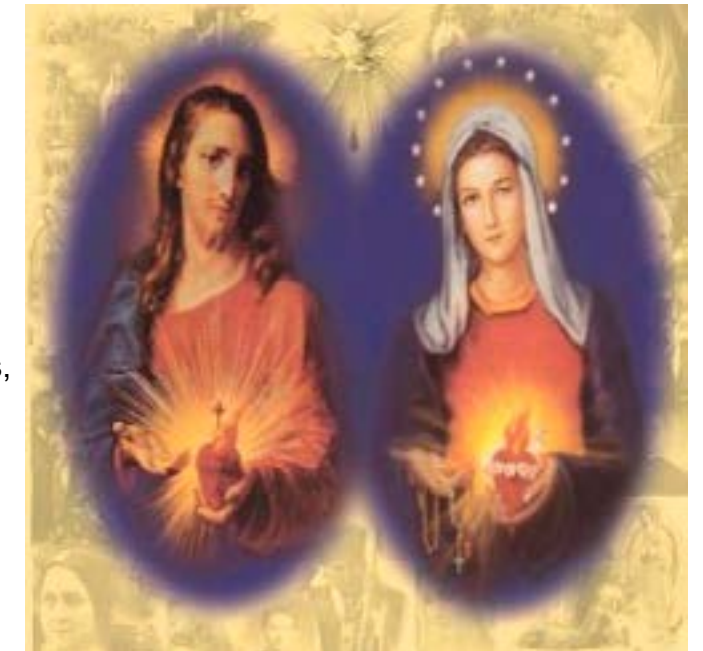
Knights of Columbus are starting to sell Christmas Ornaments after the weekend masses in July. This year we have the Star of Bethlehem/ 95th Anniversary.
