Twentieth Sunday of Ordinary Time

The Gospel this Sunday has a shocking tone as Jesus describes his mission to “set the earth on fire” because he is not coming “to establish peace on the earth . . . but rather division.” The “fire” Jesus is referencing is the power of the Holy Spirit and Judgment. This happens in a concrete way when Jesus sends the Spirit to the Church and all of us at Pentecost. It is the fire of the Holy Spirit which inspires and strengthens the Apostles to go out preaching and converting the masses. However, with each conversion, division occurs. Each Christian stands in testimony against the ways of evil, death, and the fallen condition of the world. Indeed, Christ is for setting “the earth on fire” and I tell you it is “already blazing!”

At the end of July, I was at World Youth Day with Pope Francis in Poland. 1.6 million young adults showed up, went to their knees for a candle lit prayer vigil and Eucharistic adoration. Estimates are that there were over 2 million young people at the final Mass. When and where are there gatherings of such size and people from all over the world gathered together in peace? Mind you, a sleeping pilgrim may become irritated about a snoring neighbor, a musical boy, and a hard earthen bed at two in the morning; however, despite these small inconveniences, everyone there wanted to meet new people of the Church and share faith, love, and trust in Jesus. The fire of the Spirit is strong in the Universal Church dwelling with our Pope and young people all over this earth. How glorious it is to see that this earth is “already blazing!”

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

The solemnity is not observed as a holy day of obligation in 2016, according to the USCCB’s Liturgical Calendar. Celebration of the 20th Sunday of Ordinary Time takes precedence.

Vigésimo Octavo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

El Evangelio este domingo tiene un tono impactante, ya que Jesús nos dice que viene a “traer fuego a la tierra” y no viene a “traer paz...sino la división”. El “fuego” al que se refiere Jesús es el poder del Espíritu Santo y el juicio divino. Esto sucede de una manera palpable cuando Dios manda al Espíritu a su Iglesia y a todos nosotros en Pentecostés. Es el fuego del Espíritu Santo que inspira y fortalece a los apóstoles a salir a predicar y a convertir al pueblo. Sin embargo, con cada conversión también ocurre división. Cada cristiano debe dar testimonio en contra de las acechanzas del mal, la muerte, y la condición perdida de este mundo. En efecto, Cristo quiere “traer fuego a la tierra,” y yo les digo que, ¡ya está “ardiendo!”

A finales de julio estuve en la Jornada Mundial de la Juventud en Polonia con el Santo Padre Francisco. Había 1.6 millones de jóvenes, y todos se pusieron de rodillas durante una vigilia de oración y la Adoración Eucarística. Se calcula que había más de 2 millones de jóvenes en la última misa. ¿Cuándo y en donde vemos reuniones de esta magnitud con gente de todas partes del mundo en nombre de la paz? Aunque hubo instantes como peregrino de molestarse por los ronquidos del compañero al dormir, o por un joven tocando música, o por una cama dura sobre el suelo a las dos de la mañana -- a pesar de todas estas inconveniencias, toda la gente ahí quería conocer a personas de su Iglesia con quien comparten la fe, el amor, y la confianza en Jesús. El fuego del Espíritu brilla fuerte en la Iglesia Universal, adentro de nuestro Papa y de los jóvenes a través de este mundo. ¡Qué glorioso poder ver que esta tierra ya está ardiendo!”

Calling All Married Couples - 2nd Annual "Wedding at Cana" Marriage Blessing at St. Rose of Lima

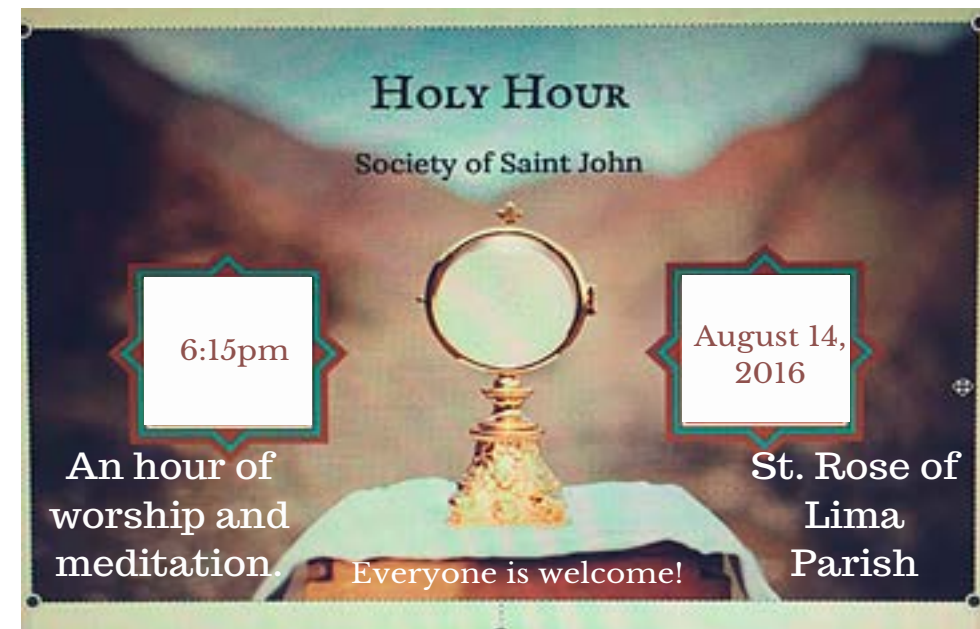

Adults! Never Been Confirmed?

If you are over 17 years old, baptized, have received First Holy Communion, but have never received the sacrament of Confirmation, St. Rose will be starting classes in September to help prepare adults for Confirmation.

Classes will be held on Sunday evenings from 6:30 PM to 8:30 PM in the DeFlores Library. Beginning with orientation on Thursday, September 8, classes continue on Sunday evenings from September 11 through November 27, 2016. Confirmation will be on Sunday, November 20 at the 5 p.m. mass.

This *12-week program* is led by experienced faith-filled instructors using Dynamic Catholic/Matthew Kelly's DecisionPoint multi-media confirmation program with online lectures and a free mobile app will guide candidate formation.
