Twenty-First Sunday of Ordinary Time

In the Gospel, Jesus makes a statement which we all can recognize: "Some are last who will be first, and some are first who will be last." We use this quote so much that it has almost become a cliché in our culture. In fact, when I was in the seminary we adjusted these words a little for dinner time saying, "Those who are first get more, and those are last don't get any." While we can have fun with overused quotes and enjoy our tradition, this quote by Jesus is very serious and important for us to understand.

The evangelist Luke's entire scripture reading places Jesus' final statement in the context of Jewish history as the leaders and prophets of Old Testament are named: "Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob". It is the Jews who first know and believe in the One True God, and a people chosen by God to be the vessel at which the Son of God is brought to the world. Even though the faith begins in the Jewish people and religion, not all believe and follow Christ. Officially, as a religion, the belief that Jesus is the Son of God is rejected. The Jews are first but they reject Christ, which may indicate their doom!

The Gentiles neither knew the One True God, nor where they chosen to be the conduit of God's divine revelation. Also, it is the Gentiles which are last to be presented with the truth through the revelation of Jesus. To the credit of the Gentiles, they have accepted Christ and continue the right teachings of God through Christianity. Essentially, the Gentiles who are last have become first in the new age of Christ's salvation. They are sitting at the front of the class.

Be careful, often people will stop at this point in understanding what Jesus states which is not complete and can lead to anti-Semitism. Remember the quote, "and some are first who will be last." This means that although Jews have set themselves at the back of the class, it does not mean they are doomed. It is now the task of the Christian—who has become first—to reveal the truth of Christ to the Jews and others. In a most marvelous way, the Glory of God is revealed. The Jews—who are first in faith—bring about salvation to Gentiles. Through Christian belief in God and the paschal mystery revealed in Jesus Christ, the Gentile has benefited. And due to Jewish deficiency in unbelief, the door is opened for the Gentile to return the favor of grace. Now the Gentile, through Jesus, can offer eternal salvation to the Jew through Christ.

And this is the challenge for the Christian faithful, to continue to reveal the paschal mystery, the Christian truth and way, each day as we live our life. The way to truly convert others to the true faith is to show the truth in who we are. If a stranger followed you around for a day, would they know you to be a faithful Catholic?

Vigésimo Primero Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

En el Evangelio Jesús dice unas palabras que todos reconocemos: "Los que son los últimos, serán los primeros; y los que son los primeros, serán los últimos." Usamos tanto esta cita que casi se ha convertido en un cliché en nuestra cultura. De hecho, cuando estaba yo en el seminario cambiamos las palabras un poco y decíamos a la hora de comer, "Los que son los primeros se sirven más, y los que son los últimos no les toca nada." Aunque es divertido cambiar palabras y disfrutar nuestra tradición, esta cita bíblica de Jesús es de gran seriedad y es importante que la comprendamos.

La escritura completa de San Lucas Evangelista pone estas palabras de Jesús dentro del contexto de la historia judía, nombrando a los líderes y profetas del Antiguo Testamento: "Abraham, Isaac y Jacob". Son los judíos que primero conocen y creen en el Único y Verdadero Dios, y son el pueblo elegido por Dios para ser el medio en el cual el Hijo de Dios es traído al mundo. Aunque la fe comienza en el pueblo y la religión judíos, no todos creen en o siguen a Cristo. Oficialmente, como religión, rechazan la creencia que Jesús es el Hijo de Dios. Los judíos son los primeros, pero rechazan a Cristo, y eso puede indicar su perdición.

Los Gentiles no conocían al Único y Verdadero Dios, ni fueron elegidos para ser el conducto de la divina revelación de Dios. Y también son los Gentiles los últimos en ser presentados con la verdad a través de la revelación de Jesús. Hay que darles crédito a los Gentiles, porque aceptaron a Cristo y observan las enseñanzas de Dios a través del Cristianismo. Esencialmente los Gentiles son los últimos que se han convertido en los primeros en la nueva era de la salvación de Cristo. Están sentados al frente de la clase.

Cuidado, porque en este punto muchas personas suelen dejar de tratar de comprender lo que Jesús está enseñando y se desvían hacia el anti-semitismo. Recuerden cuando dijo, "y los que son los primeros, serán los últimos." Esto significa que aunque los judíos se han pasado al final de la clase, no quiere decir que están condenados. Es ahora la tarea del cristiano – quien se ha convertido en el primero – de revelar la verdad de Cristo a los judíos y a otros. La Gloria de Dios se revela de una manera maravillosa. Los judíos – primeros en la fe – traen la salvación a los Gentiles, quienes se han beneficiado a través de la fe Cristiana en Dios y en el misterio pascual revelado en Jesucristo. Y debido a la deficiencia Judía en no creer, la puerta queda abierta para que el Gentil les pague el favor con gracia. Ahora el Gentil, a través de Jesús, puede ofrecer la salvación eterna al judío en Cristo.

Y este es el reto para los fieles Cristianos, de seguir revelando el misterio pascual, la verdad y el camino Cristianos, cada día de nuestras vidas. La manera de realmente convertir a los demás a la verdadera fe es de mostrar la verdad en quienes somos. Si una persona extraña te seguiría por un día entero, ¿te conocerían como un Católico fiel?
